learning events, and monthly Repair Cafés.


Repair Cafés are an international movement that we brought to Ottawa in 2017. We knew that the impacts of consumer culture extended beyond tool purchasing and implementing an event to address this seemed like the perfect fit. Our Repair Cafés are free, volunteer led events that focus on sharing repair skills and knowledge, reducing landfill waste, and building community across generations and cultures. The consistency of these events has created a thriving and dedicated community and since September 2019, our Repair Cafés have been sold out every month!

WASTE REDUCTION


Did you know that Ottawa households generate 272,692 tonnes of waste (or 271 kg of waste per person) per year? Of this, only 44% was diverted from landfills. Ottawa's Trail Road Waste Facility receives over 560,000 tonnes of waste a year and is forecast to be full by 2042.

Repairing items reduces the volume of raw materials and energy used to make new products, while simultaneously redirecting items from our landfills. The graph to the right showcases the types of items that we help to divert at our Repair Cafés.
